All applicants need to appear in person at the Pretoria Consulate. Those flying from other provinces need to arrange flights before the appointment date. Please speak to your visa consultant for the next available appointment.

Submissions are from Monday to Thursday only and submission appointments are required, which may delay the processing time by a further 5-7 business days.

Valid Passport validity 6 months after date of return - note that all below documents need to be submitted in duplicate, excluding original passport, photos and application form must be completed in black capital letters

Application form.

Copy of applicant's ID and/or birth certificate in case of minor

Three passport-size photos.

Copy of flight schedule.

Company letter from South Africa explaining the reason for travelling to Morocco.

An original certified (South African Commissioner of Oath local Police Station) Invitation from Moroccan citizen or resident with a copy of identity document.

Travel Insurance for the full duration of stay in Morocco

Accommodation voucher for the full duration of stay on the Hotel-s letterhead, vouchers not accepted - confirmation required.

Financial - 3 Months Original Latest Bank Statements

South African Travelers ID Copy - For Foreigners a Valid Permit

Processing time is STRICTLY 10-15 business days. Submissions are from Monday to Thursday only and submission appointments are required, which may delay the processing time by a further 5-7 business days.
